3. **Transcript of Records** - proof of academic achievements, copy of Bachelor's degree certificate (Master's level students only)
4. **Proof of English language skills**
5. **Curriculum vitae**
6. **Photograph** - for your student ID
7. **Passport**

Letter of acceptance

Please note that we will only accept complete applications. After the application deadline, your documents will be forwarded to the respective faculty for evaluation. If your application is accepted, you'll receive an official letter of acceptance and your signed Learning Agreement.

Semester fee

There are no tuition fees at HTWK Leipzig, but students are charged a semester fee, which is used to finance student services and gives students full access to the public transportation system. The semester fee is currently ca. 270 Euro.
