



Freelance English Teacher for Technical English



The Foreign Languages Department at HTWK Leipzig, University of Applied Sciences, is offering multiple English teaching jobs on a freelance basis in summer semester 2026, for instance:

- "English for Specific Purposes (B2): Electrical Engineering and Information Technology" for students of the Bachelor's degree course Electrical Engineering and Information Technology, each course comprising 90 min per week.
- "Academic and Vocational English (B2)" for students of the Bachelor's degree course Industrial Engineering/Civil Engineering, each course comprising 90 min per week.

Teaching weeks comprise calendar weeks 15-28 in the year 2026. All courses include the responsibility to administer oral and written student examinations (to be scheduled in weeks 30-32/2026).

Our Requirements:

- recognised university degree,
- degree or certificate in English language teaching / didactics, or
- experience and knowledge in EFL / ESP teaching, assessing and examining, preferably at an institution of higher education,
- knowledge in the fields of e-learning / blended learning and learning management systems,
- English language skills on level C1 CEFR or higher,
- German language skills on level A2 CEFR or higher,
- the legal right to work in Germany / tax identification number.

We pay 70,- EUR per double teaching unit of 90 minutes, including a fixed amount of 10,- EUR per double teaching unit as examinations are involved. Remuneration is on a freelance basis in accordance with the guidelines of HTWK Leipzig for teaching assignments. The position is self-employed and not subject to social security contributions.
